

SOCIAL SERVICES RELIEF FUND (SSRF 4)

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

Capital funding	The total SSRF 4 Capital Component funding allocation is \$10,829,189. Your organization may choose to apply for all of the funding, or a portion of the funding. The SSRF 4 Capital component will fund up to 100% of the development costs less HST rebates.
Fiscal Year	Provincial fiscal year that spans from April 1 st of one year to March 31 st of the following year.
Household	Applies to a person or group of persons who occupy the same dwelling and do not have a usual place of residence elsewhere in Canada or abroad. The dwelling may be either a collective dwelling or a private dwelling. The household may consist of a family group such as a census family, of two or more families sharing a dwelling or of a person living alone.
Indigenous People	People who self-identify as First Nations, Inuit, or Métis
Indigenous Program Administrator	Ontario Aboriginal Housing Support Services Corporation
Service Provider	An Indigenous non-profit organization incorporated (or in the process of incorporating) under the laws of the Province of Ontario or under the <i>Canada Not-for-profit Corporations Act</i> that satisfies all the Eligibility Criteria prescribed in the RFP
Affordable Rent for Capital Funding	Rents cannot exceed 80% of Average Market Rent (AMR) as determined by CMHC AMR for each City/Town or Region.
Affordability Period for Capital Funding	Rents must not exceed 80% of AMR for a minimum of 10 years from initial occupancy.
