

Mkaana-wii-giiwe'aad "Finding their way Home" Program

What is Homelessness?

Homelessness can mean many things and there is no clear definition.

If you are one or more of these, the Mkaana'aa wii-giiwe'aad Program may be able to assist you.

- □ Have no home
- ☐ Living on the streets
- Staying in shelters
- Leaving jail, hospital or detox centre with no fixed address
- Escaping violence and/or human trafficking
- ☐ Youth leaving the child welfare system
- ☐ Residential School Survivor
- Living on couches





At OAHS we use a cultural approach to help people find housing. We believe that a strong sense of culture is important for healing and identity.

At OAHS we use:

- An Indigenous approach
- □ Cultural Assessments
- Medicine Wheel Teachings
- Smudging
- □ Referrals to Indigenous agencies (Indian Friendship Centre, Metis Nation)
- ☐ Access to culture programs (sweat lodges, teachings)
- □ Access to traditional healing services

Mkaana'aa wii-giiwe-aad Case Managers will provide culturally appropriate assessment tools guided by Indigenous knowledge holders and experts in the field of supportive housing and help you on your journey.
